一、评分原则:

1. 本题总分为: A) 10分; B) 15分。按四个档次给分。

二、各档次的给分范围和要求:

第四档(很好): A) 9—10分; B) 13—15分

完全完成了试题规定的要求,覆盖所有内容要点,符合英语表达习惯,应用了较多的语法结构和词汇,没有语法和词汇错误,具备较强的语言运用能力,完全达到了预期的写作目的。

第三档(好): A) 6—8分; B) 9—12分

完成了试题规定的要求,应用的语法结构和词汇能满足题目的要求,符合英语表达习惯,基本没有语法和词汇错误,达到了预期的写作目的。

第二档(一般): A) 4—5分; B) 5—8分

未恰当完成试题规定的要求,漏掉内容要点,未描述清楚主要内容,写了一些无关内容,有语法和词汇错误,影响了对写作内容的理解,信息未能清楚地传达给读者。

第一档(差): A) 1—3分; B) 1—4分

未完成试题规定的要求,明显遗漏主要内容,写了一些无关内容,语法结构单调,词汇有限,有较多语法和词汇错误,影响对写作内容的理解,信息未能准确地传达给读者。

未能传达给读者任何信息,没有内容或内容太少,无法评判,写的内容均与所要求内容无关或所写内容无法看清。
